Stories must showcase the effects of the farm dog in the day to day operations of working alongside California farmers or ranchers. All entrants must be a member of a county Farm Bureau or minor child of a member

Printed photos:

- A completed entry form must be attached to the back of **each** photo.
- Photos must be at least 5x7 inches but no larger than 8-1/2x11 inches.
- Photos must be printed at the highest printer setting on photographic paper.

Online photo entries:

- Photos must have a resolution of 6 megapixels or greater and be in .jpg format.
- Submitted photos should at a minimum be 300 dpi at 10 inches wide. The file size should be about 8-10 MB and no less than 6 MB
